- 4. This forum will function experimentally till February 2018. If necessary will be increased its period.
- 5. The meeting announced 3 co-chair for cxb cso-ngo forum. Following person will be nominated as co-chair.

Mr. Abu Morshed Chowdhury, Executive Director, PHALSE will be acting co-chair till February 2018. He will attend different NGO, INGO and ISCG meeting behalf of cxb cso-ngo forum.

- 6. A LNGO-INGO meeting will be held on November 2017. All organization will present their plann and program in the meeting.
- 7. COAST will be accomplished secretarial duty of cxb cso-ngo forum. Nobody will command to cxb cso-ngo forum member
- 8. Main stakeholder of cxb cso-ngo forum are, INGO, UN agencies and DC office and other govt. office.
- 9. All management of cxb cso-ngo forum will be conducted by sharing each-other.
- 10. Forum leader should have clear knowledge finance and governance.
- 11. Mr. Rezaul Karim Chowdhury placed a position paper of cxb cso-ngo forum in the meeting on basis of Rohingya influx in Cox's Bazar and created present environmental, socio-economic crisis. The meeting has decided a press conference will be held on 19 October 2017 at Cox's Bazar Press club to focusing position paper. Invited all cxb cso-ngo forum mmember to attend the press conferenc.
