Mr Rezaul Karim Chowdhury welcomed all who attended the meeting. He explained that, the importance of ngo's coordination meeting and supporting Rohingya's in humanitarian aspect, how ngo's will have work together. He said, No alternative way organizing coordination meeting to know who working what and where. It is necessary for us to shared each other on ngo's futur planning and working area and seat coordination meeting, he said.

All participants shared their opinion and experience in the meeting and following proposal was taken unanimasously:

1. NGO's coordination meeting will be continued in futur. All focal person of ngo's will have attend the coordination meeting and requested them.
2. NGO's will have shared with each other and informed who doing what for Rohingya Refugee. If every ngo's shared their plan and problem with each other then all are informed everybodies work details and what facing problem. So sharing information is needed.
3. Experience shows that, to recieve high oficial of NGO Bureau's had not any plan at past of ngo's. So that, there was created a miss-management situation. Decided that to receiving any high official of ngo bureau will have planned to coordinated away for doing who will do what.
4. Local ngo's representative should have attended in INGO's meeting for increasing their coordination and capacity. By attending the INGOs meetinglocal NGOs could collect information of present situation of Camps and relief oparetion.
5. Before attend the meeting of district administration all ngos shoud organize a prior preparation meeting for better presentation of NGOs. NGOs can discussed their problem before attend the meeting and taking initiative collectively.
6. Next NGO coordination meeting will be hold 20th September 2017 ant COAST office. All are requested to attend the meeting.
7. A format will be developped by COAST for providing NGOs informations. (name of work, working area, future plan etc). The format will be sent with invitation letter of next coordination meeting.
8. Mr. Tarek Sayed Harun presented a need assessment report for Rohingya's(Tube well, food, water etc) has presented in the meeting. The report will be sent all later.
9. A group e-mail of NGOs who have benn working in Cox's Bazar will be prepared by COAST IT section (Tauhidul Alam).
10. NGOs will have organized a campaign meeting with help of local civil society leader alongside support releif operational works for their (Rohingya) dignity. We will have aware not to harrassed, underminde them. Because Rohingya women and man, girls and children are murdered and oppressed by Military janta of Myanmar.
11. Dialogue will be continued by Bangladesh Government to repartiot of Rohingya.

12. Rohingya people should settled a confind camp area.
