It is also true that if there are humanitarian response through local CSO-NGO and local government then the cost will be less.</p> <p>During August 2017 while the Rohingya influx started it is the local governments and local CSO-NGOs has played great role in the beginning.</p> <p>World humanitarian summit which was concluded during May 2016 through Grand Bargain commitment which have had given importance on localization accepting the role of local CSO-NGOs and local governments.</p> <p>UN agencies has formed a group Strategic Executive Group (SEG) in respect of Rohingya response. They have formed a Localization Task Force (LTF) which was led by Country Representative of UNDP and IFRC. The group has assign Centre for Peace and Justice (CPJ) of BRAC University, they have prepared a localization road map in participation with all possible stakeholders, finally they have submitted a report in this regard. Localization road map in respect of Rohingya response has published recently.</p> <p>It is a session to bring good evidences from Coxsbazar Rohingya response and to do brain storming for future strategy in this regard.</p>
