Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Listen the stories of the front line workers who face difficulties in respect of their work and campaign during this COVID 19 period. 2. Encourage and respect those front line workers in this difficult period of humanitarian period in Coxsbazar.
Background	<p>Coxsbazar CSO NGO Forum (CCNF, www.cxb-cso-ngo.org) a network of around 50 NGO CSO working in Coxsbazar, primarily to promote human and gender rights in Coxsbazar in keeping positive engagement with our government. COAST (www.coastbd.net) is working as secretariat for the network. Since August 2017 Rohingya influx CCNF has organized around 20 public events like seminars, webinars, press conference, grass root mobilization to promote primacy of government leadership in Rohingya response (e.g., a single line and single pot management taking UN agencies role as counterpart), aid transparency, technology transfer to the locals, participation of local government and local NGOs in Response Management and Joint Response Planning (JRP) etc.</p> <p>CCNF is continuously and consistently pursuing localization in view of the UN and INGO commitment on Principle of Partnership (PoP, 2007), Charter 4 Change (C4C) and Grand Bargain (2016) agreements as initiated by UN. A Localization Task Force (LTF) have been created by UN agencies, they have engaged Center for Peace and Justice (CPJ) of BRAC University to propose a localization road map. Considering the situation moreover considering the dwindling situation of aid, CCNF urge UN to expedite the process of declaring the localization road map. CCNF believes in complementarity and inclusiveness in the response management, its believe that UN and INGOs should play its role in monitoring and technical assistance while field operation should be with local (locally origin and with local leadership) NGOs and national NGOs.</p> <p>After COVID 19, humanitarian response perspective has been changed, with this view UN highest body on Humanitarian Response the IASC (Inter Agency Standing Committee) issued Interim Guideline on Localization during COVID 19 (May 2020) where role of local actors like local NGOs and local government has given highest importance, as the expatriate has to face a lot of limitation to face the situation in front line. Moreover localization is the process for minimizing the cost, technology and know-how transfer to locals, locally led and to make the response locally accountable. IASC guideline have also given importance to risk sharing and care to the front line workers.</p> <p>World Humanitarian Day (WHD) observed on 19th August in each year by humanitarian agencies with a call from UN. This year the call is to respect to front line workers who are working for COVID 19 in front line. Taking these in line, CCNF want to organize this event to respect front line workers in this regard, it is reported that around 160 front line local staff have been found COVID 19 positive in Ukhiya especially in Rohingya response.
